GRADING

Condition

At TRIXON B.V., we ensure transparency and quality in our refurbished devices by using a clear grading system. Each device is carefully inspected, tested, and categorized based on its cosmetic condition and functionality. Our grading system—A, AB, BC and D—helps customers make informed decisions by providing a clear understanding of the device's quality. Below is an overview of what each grade represents.

As new (A)	 Case: no or only very minor scratches. Screen: no or only very minor scratches.
	 Functionality: OK.
Very Good (AB)	 Case: visible scratches and/or minor dents. May have slight sticker marks on the back casing, barely noticeable.
	 Screen: may have minor scratches, invisible when the screen is on.
	 Functionality: OK.
Used (BC)	 Case: very visible scratches and/or heavy dents. Worn keyboard and/or faded letters. Screen: has very visible scratches and/or is scratched or chipped. Visible when the screen is on. Presence of dust specks and/or dirt inside the screen. Functionality: OK.
Faulty (D)	 Case: might have cracks Screen: might have cracks Functionality: faulty or locked




GRADING A

Devices in Grade A are in excellent condition, both cosmetically and functionally. They show little to no signs of use and work like new. Perfect for customers looking for top-quality refurbished devices.











GRADING AB

Grade AB devices are fully functional and in very good cosmetic condition. They may show light signs of use, such as small scratches or minor marks, but nothing that affects performance. A great choice for those seeking value with minimal wear.










GRADING BC

Devices in Grade BC are used and show visible signs of wear, such as scratches, scuffs, or small dents. Despite the cosmetic imperfections, they are fully functional and have been thoroughly tested. Ideal for budget-conscious users who prioritize performance over appearance.







GRADING D

Grade D devices are faulty or only partially functional. They may have hardware or software issues and are sold for parts, repair, or refurbishment. These devices are intended for technicians or customers who understand the risks and potential repair needs.
